Growing Points Disclosure Statement

This is a disclosure statement which you should discuss with your customer at your first meeting. It is important that customers understand that if we hear something which is not safe for them or others, we will have to act on it. In addition, with their consent we might want to use their success story as a case study, anonymised of course:

I am really looking forward to working with you.

Before we start working together I need to make you aware of a couple of things. We will usually keep everything you tell us confidential.

There are exceptions, for example, if you tell us something which means:

1. you are doing something which could do harm to yourself or to other people or
2. you have broken the law, or
3. someone is doing something to you which is against the law:

We may have to tell other organizations eg social services or the police about it for your safety or the safety of others.

We also want to be able to show the work we do with people is helping. We will not share identifiable information about you but we will be asking you to tell us about your experience of working with us and maybe share your story with others if you want to. We will always ask for your consent about this.

Review

The effectiveness of this policy will be reviewed on annual basis by the Board of Trustees under the supervision of the Operation Director.
